

CRITERIA FOR MUS DEPENDENT HARDSHIP PREMIUM WAIVER APPLICATION

1. Must have applied for Healthy Montana Kids Program (HMK) for dependents aged 0 – 19, and been denied (must have letter of denial) and denial cannot be for coverage on MUS insurance, because of agreement with HMK
2. Dependents ages 19-26 are eligible to apply for hardship waiver based on their ineligibility to participate in HMK Program
3. Total family income must be 115% of HMK income guideline
4. List all sources of income – wages, tips, child support, alimony, etc
5. Provide documentation of household income (such as a tax return, W2s, paycheck remittance, etc)
6. Provide list of everyone who lives with you – including name, relationship, age, gender
7. Provide a description of any medical or financial hardship you may have incurred
